Dear Brainerd Public Schools Family,

The Minnesota Department of Health, in collaboration with MDE and Governor Walz's office, continue to recommend that Minnesota schools remain open as per our scheduled calendar. There are, however, many principles set forth as strategies for management in the near future. Brainerd Public Schools will stay current with updates from these professionals as we move through the COVID-19 plan and recommendations. Please be advised, Brainerd Public Schools has no one in our school community identified with COVID-19.

Brainerd Public Schools are continuously in touch with the Minnesota Department of Health and other state and local officials as we learn of changes and communicate next steps with you. This pandemic is ever-evolving so we ask that you watch for regular management updates from District Communications. As you can imagine, rumor and speculation abound, so if you hear anything of concern or if you have a question, please email communications@isd181.org or call the Health Department hotline at 651-201-3920 directly.

In the meantime, you may be asking what are some things you can do to reduce the risk of getting this virus or **any** viral respiratory infection. The following actions are endorsed:

- Protect yourself and others by washing your hands often with soap and water; cover your cough and sneeze with your elbow avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands. Learn the proper way to [wash hands](#) and [cover coughs and sneezes](#).
- If you or your child are sick, stay home until you are fever-free without medication for 24 hours. Do not return to school or work until you are feeling better and a fever is gone for at least 24 hours without using fever-reducing medication.
- Be prepared in case you get sick and need to stay home. Keep enough food, regular prescription drugs, and other necessities on hand in case you need to stay home and are not able to go out.
- Frequently clean all commonly touched work surfaces, work areas, and equipment (e.g., telephones, doorknobs, lunch areas, countertops, copies, etc.).

As a precaution, Brainerd Public Schools will also begin implementing social distancing measures, such as standing 6 feet away from others, not shaking hands, and limiting large group assemblies.
